

# Bulldogs continue winning series

**Dornbirn/01-11-2017 - In round 42 of the Erste Bank Eishockey Liga the Dornbirner Eishockey Club celebrated a 4:0-home victory against Fehervar AV19. The team from Vorarlberg not only continued their winning streak, but is also demonstrating an upturn in form lately, just before the crucial phase of the Championship.**

The Hungarian team as well as the Bulldogs won't make it into the Pick-Round, that was clear before the start of Wednesday night's game. Exactly two months after their last encounter in Dornbirn, it was all about collecting bonus points for the Qualification Round for both teams. Dornbirn had increased their self-confidence lately, and made that quite clear from the beginning of the match. Eight minutes into the game the Bulldogs went into the lead. Jamie Arniel (8.), assisted by Daniel Ban, took care of the 1:0. The Red Devils were fighting hard to hit back, but without any measurable success. The second goal of the evening got scored by the home team as well. This time Cody Sylvester (26.) succeeded, assisted by Kevin Macierzynski.

Early decision by Niki Petrik

Although the play was overall pretty evenly-matched during the first two periods, the Bulldogs were much more efficient playing 5 on 5. With two minutes remaining in the second Niki Petrik (38.) used a rebound to make for the 3:0, the puck went between goalie Hetenyi's legs. After video decision the referees decided on "no goal" after an alleged shorthander by Jamie Arniel. Fehervar kept fighting, but the team of DEC-Headcoach Dave McQueen didn't let anything get in their way anymore. On a powerplay with two minutes left in the match Brock McBride (58./pp) took care of the 4:0, the final score. Bulldogs goalie Florian Hardy celebrated another shutout against the Magyars.
